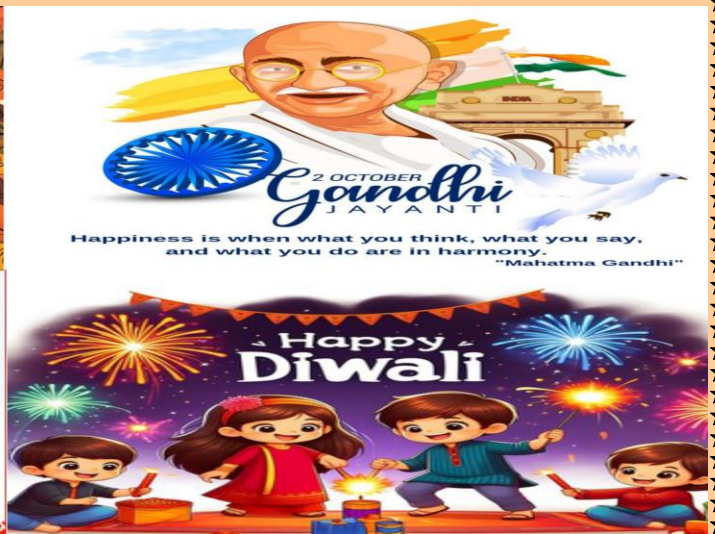
CLASS-PREPARATORY
