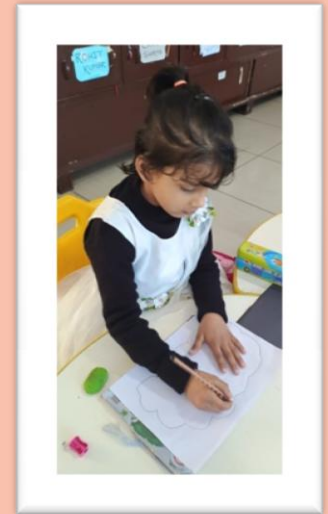
The interactive session enhanced students' awareness and equipped them with valuable information to make informed decisions about their future endeavors.

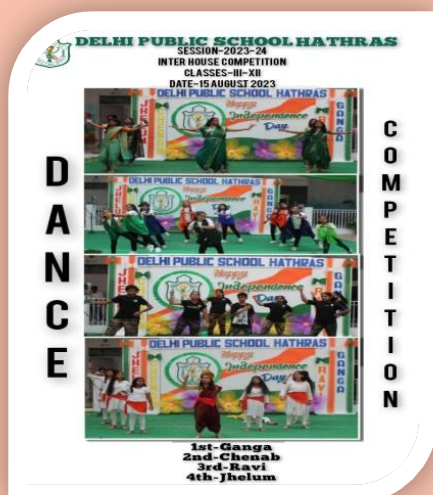

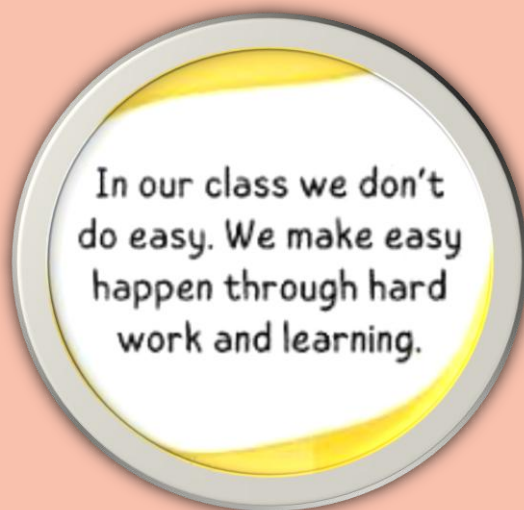
