
Workshop on Career Counselling

- The Session started with the group activity called "Lets work in groups". It served its purpose of getting the group members to think out of the box and understand each other. It was emphasized that the students should also be guided in a similar fashion. Additionally, Time Management, Classroom Strategy, Promoting Mental Health, Developing Academic and Behavior Support System were organized in house. All the teachers in attendance participated and shared their experiences with great zeal and enthusiasm was incomparable during the session. The workshop was an effort to make teachers realize that they need to be experimenters and problem solvers by putting themselves in shoes of students, who often fail to understand or face difficulties.
