- Reading is the most stimulating and wonderful pastime in summer holidays. Inculcate in your child the habit of listening stories.
- Play simple indoor games like Scrabble, Chess, word building.
- Help your parents and grandparents in daily chores like dusting, watering the plants etc.

- Inculcate good habits in your children.
- Motivate them to keep their things in proper order and keep their room clean.
- Buttoning and unbuttoning the shirt
- Arranging his/her toy shelf
- Folding mats and clothes
- Keep their surrounding neat and clean
- Sorting and pairing household items
- Water the plants and feed the birds
- Encourage your ward to converse in English at home
- Regular reading and writing is very important

Use these phrases in day to day life:-

ENGLISH :

Q1. Draw a flower with 7 petals and write name of seven common noun in it.

Q2. Paste the pictures of 10 proper nouns along with their names.

Q3. Write 10 lines about your best friend on A-4 sheet

Q4. Paste or draw 10 emoji's on colourful sheet and write its name.

Q5. Paste 2 pictures of places you visit in summer vacation on A-4 sheet and write 5 lines on it.

HINDI:

प्रश्न2. पाठ्य पुस्तक से अतिरिक्त कोई कविता लिखकर याद करिए तथा वीडियो भी बनाइए ।

प्रश्न3. शब्दों की माल बनाइए - कोई भी एक मात्रा चुनिए (जैसे- आ की मात्रा) और उससे बनने वाले 5 शब्दों की माला (जैसे- आम, कम, नाम, दाम, राम) बनाइए।

प्रश्न4. भाषा का पेड़ - एक पेड़ का चित्र बनाकर उसकी जड़ों में - भाषा, तने- में शब्द और पत्तियों - में स्वर और व्यंजन लिखिए ।

प्रश्न5. मेरी मात्रा वाली कहानी बनाइए -

नीचे दिए गए शब्दों का उपयोग करके एक छोटी सी कहानी बनाइए । हर शब्द में एक मात्रा है उन मात्राओं को रंगीन करिए । (शब्द: फूल, राजा, किताब, पानी, सूरज)

MATHEMATICS :

Q1. Colourful Table Flower: Choose multiplication tables from 11 to 15 (e.g., the table of 12) and write each one inside the petals of a large flower. Color each petal with a different colour.

Q2. My Number Poster (Numbers up to 999): Choose any 3 numbers between 100 and 999. For each number, do the following:

1. Write the number.

2. Break it into hundreds, tens, and ones.

3. Say if it's an even or odd number.

Q3. My Number Name Family Book: Make a small booklet using A4 sheets. Each page must consist of a number, its name, and something from real life:

"Five – I have 5 fingers on one hand."

Q4. My Shape Robot : Create a robot using different cut-out shapes (circle head, rectangle body, square arms, triangle feet, etc.).

Paste it on paper and label each shape used.

Give your robot a name.

Q5. Math Tree : Draw a big tree with 10 leaves.

Write one addition or subtraction fact on each leaf.

Example: Leaf 1. $8 + 2 = 10$, Leaf 2. $15 - 5 = 10$

ENVIRONMENTAL - STUDIES :

Q1. Go for a walk in a park or garden with your parents. Note down three things you see, 2 things you hear and 1 thing you smell on A4 size sheet. Draw your favorite part of the walk.

Q2. Cut and paste pictures of healthy foods from newspapers/magazines. Make your "Healthy Plate" on a paper plate or A4 size sheet. Label the food groups (fruits, vegetables, grains etc.)

Q3. Make a poster showing how to save water at home. Draw a picture and write a simple slogan like "Every Drop Counts!" On A4 size sheet.

Q4. List 5 neighbourhood places near your home (like hospital, park, school)

Draw or paste pictures on A4 size sheet and write their names.

Q5. Choose your favorite animal (wild or pet). Draw it on A4 size sheet and write 5 facts about it.

Example: It lives in the forest. It has a long trunk. It is world's largest land animal.

Note: Prepare a thin notebook for holiday homework.
