Arrange the numbers in ascending and descending order. 3- Find the age of 5 of your family members and write them in roman numerals using matchsticks on A4 sheet. 4- Draw pictures of 5 objects around your home that show: •Shapes (circle, square, rectangle, triangle) •Numbers (house number, calendar, clock) •Measurements (ruler, weighing scale) Paste them on A4 sheet with a small description.</p>
