ENGLISH	<p>1- Every new word is a key that opens a door to a bigger, brighter world. Create your own 'Word Wizard' by hunting a new word daily from television or newspaper and write its meaning and a sentence. Also add drawings, if possible. (On thin diary/Notebook)</p> <p>2- Nouns are the stars of every sentence. Make a 'Noun Comic Fold-able' on A4 sheet by following the given instructions: * Take an A4 sheet, fold it into 4 flaps. * Label each flap: Proper Noun, Common Noun, Collective Noun, Abstract Noun * Under each flap: Write a definition with 2 examples and draw one picture.</p> <p>3- "Every family has a story to tell". So in your words, write a paragraph on most memorable moment spent with your family and paste the picture of the moment if possible to make it more creative, on A4 sheet.</p>
HINDI	<p>प्रश्न 1. मात्रा जादू – शब्द बनाओ: नीचे दिए गए बिना मात्रा वाले अक्षरों से मात्रा जोड़कर नए शब्द बनाओ और उन्हें चित्र के साथ सजाओ। उदाहरण: क + मात्रा = का, कि, की, कु, कू, के... (कम से कम 5 नए शब्द बनाओ)</p> <p>प्रश्न 2. वर्णों की रंगोली: हिंदी वर्णमाला के स्वर और व्यंजन को रंग-बिरंगे फूलों या कागज से एक रंगोली के रूप में सजाओ।</p> <p>प्रश्न 3. कहानी में खोजो मात्रा: अपनी पसंदीदा हिंदी कहानी की किताब से एक छोटा अनुच्छेद लिखो और उसमें प्रयुक्त मात्राओं को रंगीन पेन से अलग-अलग रंग में चिह्नित करो। (जैसे – आ की मात्रा – लाल, ई की मात्रा – नीला आदि)</p> <p>प्रश्न 4. भाषा का महत्व – पोस्टर बनाओ: "भाषा – हमारी पहचान" इस विषय पर एक सुंदर पोस्टर बनाओ और 3-4 पंक्तियाँ लिखो कि भाषा हमारे जीवन में क्यों ज़रूरी है।</p> <p>प्रश्न 5. वर्णमाला पहेली: स्वयं से एक वर्णमाला पहेली बनाओ। जैसे – "मैं एक ऐसा अक्षर हूँ जो 'नाव' के अंत में आता है और 'सपना' में बीच में आता है, बताओ मैं कौन हूँ?" (कम से कम 3 पहेलियाँ बनाओ और उनके उत्तर नीचे लिखो)</p>
MATHEMATICS	<p>1- Learn & write multiplication tables from 11 to 20 in rough notebook.</p> <p>2- We live by numbers, but remember life in colors, scents, and sounds. Time to converse the Calendar- Take a month's calendar and rewrite all the dates (1-31) in Roman numerals. Pick three special dates and write one-line note about why they're important. (On A4 sheet)</p> <p>3- Draw some geometrical shapes like square, circle, triangle etc. on glaze paper and cut them out. Prepare any five things using the cutout of those shapes by pasting them on A4 sheet. (For eg.- hut, boat, animal face, rocket, rangoli etc.)</p> <p>4- Make a model of Roman numeral clock face with Roman numerals I-XII.</p>
SCIENCE	<p>1) Make booklet showing different types of clothes (cotton, woollen, Georgette, nylon, chiffon etc)</p> <p>2) Make a creative project showing life cycle of a butterfly.</p> <p>3) create a fold-able appealing menu card for an imaginary restaurant that show cases a variety of food categories.</p> <p>4) Save the Environment Make a poster on how we can save air, water, and soil.</p>

You can present your work in a scrapbook, chart paper, or as a PowerPoint (with the help of parents if needed).</p> <p>Activity 1: Map Magic</p> <p>Paste a map of India.</p> <p>Mark and label any 5 states with their capitals.</p> <p>Paste or draw one famous thing (like food, clothing, monument) from each state.</p> <p>Activity 2: Our National Symbols</p> <p>Create a small booklet on National Symbols of India (Flag, Emblem, Animal, Bird, Flower, Tree, Song, etc.).</p> <p>Draw or paste pictures and write 1-2 lines about each.</p> <p>Activity 3: Community Helpers Collage</p> <p>Make a collage showing different community helpers (doctor, teacher, farmer, etc.).</p> <p>Write a few lines on how they help our society.</p> <p>Activity 4: Festivals of India</p> <p>Choose any 3 Indian festivals (one religious, one national, one seasonal).</p> <p>Paste pictures and write about how and why each is celebrated.</p> <p>Activity 5: My Dream City</p> <p>Imagine your dream city.</p> <p>Draw a layout showing roads, parks, schools, hospitals, etc.</p> <p>Write a short paragraph on why you would love to live there.</p>
