- You are welcome.

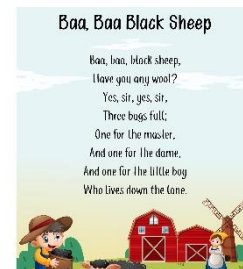
Be a good and responsible child and Parents need to ask their child the following points:-

ENGLISH

1- Sing-Along Sessions



Activity: Teach your child simple English songs and rhymes like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" or "Baa, Baa, Black Sheep." Encourage them to sing along with actions. Make a video of an activity and send it with class teacher. (video should not be more than 30 sec.)

2-Story Time with Puppets

Activity: Read simple stories like "The Three Little Pigs" or "The Tortoise and the Hare." Afterward, help your child create simple puppets of the characters using paper bags or socks. Encourage them to retell the story using the puppets.

2.Line Decoration Activity



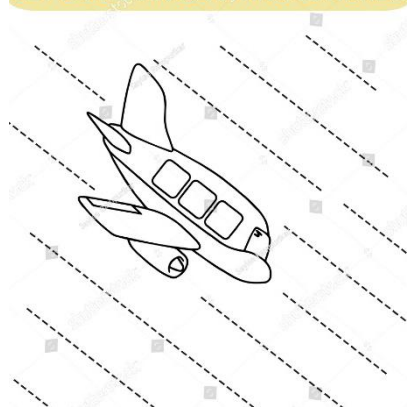
Pre-writing Skills- Trace the Lines

LET US LEARN SLANTING STROKES



Materials Required: A4 sheets, glue, bindis, pulses (dal), rice grains.

Activity:

Draw a Standing line and have the child decorate it with bindis.

Draw a sleeping line and let the child paste pulses (dal) along it.

For left and right slanting lines, use rice grains for decoration. This activity combines art with learning line concepts and enhances tactile experiences.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

1-My Family Tree



Objective: Help children understand family relationships.

Activity: Create a simple family tree using photos or drawings of family members. Label each member (e.g., Mama, Papa, Dadi, Dada, etc).

Skills Developed: Family awareness, vocabulary, relational understanding.

2-Nature Art



Objective: Encourage creativity using natural materials.

Activity: Collect leaves, flowers, and twigs during a nature walk. Use these to create art pieces like leaf rubbings or flower collages.

Skills Developed: Creativity, fine motor skills, appreciation of nature.
