ENGLISH	<p>1- Find out new words from your coursebook / newspaper. Write the meaning and one sentence of that particular word in rough notebook. (2 words daily)</p> <p>2- Read any two Aesop's fables from the internet or borrow any story book from school library and write short summary with the moral of the story on A4 sheet. (Hint: Some Aesop's fables are- The Wind and the sun, The Milkmaid and her pail, The Bowman and the lion etc)</p> <p>3- Make an attractive chart in tabular form on A4 sheet showing ten examples of different types of nouns like common, proper, abstract, countable, uncountable, collective noun etc.</p> <p>4- "Every family has a story to tell". So in your words, write a paragraph on most memorable moment spent with your family and paste the picture of the moment if possible to make it more creative ,on A4 sheet.</p>
