# **MATHEMATICS:**

1.Learn and write multiplication table from 11 to 20 in rough notebook.

2. Find the age of 5 of your family members and write them in Roman numerals using matchsticks, buttons or any other articles.

3.Form ten, 4-digit numbers using digit 0 to 9 and make a colourful place value chart on A4 sheet.

4. Make a number garden using even and odd number flower vases by following the given instructions-

Cut out 20 colourful paper flowers of small size and write any 10 even numbers and 10 odd numbers between 1-500 on them and make two flower vases on two separate A4 sheet-one of even number and other of odd number,put the even and odd numbers in respective flower vases and decorate your garden.

### **SCIENCE:**

1. Collect and paste five pictures of different animals and classify them as herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.

2. Draw well labelled diagram of the following-

a. Photosynthesis

B. Water Cycle

3. Draw the picture of

a. 5 Luminous and 5 non luminous objects

b. 5 living and 5 non living things on A4 size sheet.

4. Using natural material such as fallen leaves, dry twins, thin sticks, pebbles, shells, seeds and glue, make any two human made things and two things that resemble natural things.

#### SOCIAL SCIENCE:

1. Draw and colour the pictures that we see on land and in the sky on A4 size sheet.

Land - houses, trees, bridge, hill, river, snow

Sky- Sun, stars, Moon, rainbow

2. Plastic choke aquatic life. Being light, plastic floats on water thereby stopping oxygen supply that is so essential for aquatic plants and animals. Design a poster on 'Say No to Plastic Bags.'

3. Make a list of 6 community helpers. Write their names, profession and how they are helpful for the community. Draw and colour their pictures on A4 size sheet.

4. Draw and colour the solar system (showing all planets) and parts of leaf on A4 size sheet.
